DANGEROUS FOOTPATH AND DUMPED WASTE

Residents have complained to Eric regarding the dangerous state of the footpath running from Hacken Lane to Radcliffe Road, Darcy Lever. Eric has been in discussions with Bolton Council because the footpath did have good wooden fence protecting users from a 30ft drop in to the River Croal.

It would appear that the fence is on private land and not Council owned. Due to this they are not prepared to do anything to protect users of the footpath, but say it is down to the owners of the land to carry out repairs. The council has said it will contact the land owners about the repairs which are needed.



These massive containers and a large amount of Industrial waste have been dumped on land next to the footpath from Hacken Lane to Radcliffe Road. Eric has asked the council to try and get the land owners to remove this waste material.

Eric has asked Transport for Greater Manchester to look into providing a bus shelter at Bromwich Street next to Kirkwall Drive, Darcy Lever. He will inform you of any progress.



BUS STOP INFORMATION BOARDS.

Transport for Greater Manchester removed all of the information boards from the bus stops in Darcy Lever. Residents contacted Eric and he has got TFGM to reinstate them to some of the stops.

OFF ROAD AND QUAD BIKES

Eric has been contacted regarding the noise, the danger being caused to pedestrians, dog walkers, horse riders and model plane enthusiasts by the use of Moses Gate Country Park by off road bikes and quad bikes. The aircraft field had fencing broken down and as been turned into a quagmire, meaning it is now unusable. Eric contacted the police and Bolton Council who together taking action, cctv surveillance has been installed and regular police activity to try and stop the nuisance. The council have said they will make the field usable again when the conditions improve for the summer and re fence the area.
