Following a litter pick by schools on the fields at the rear of Bowness Road these bags were left for six days before being collected. Eric contacted the Council to get them removed.



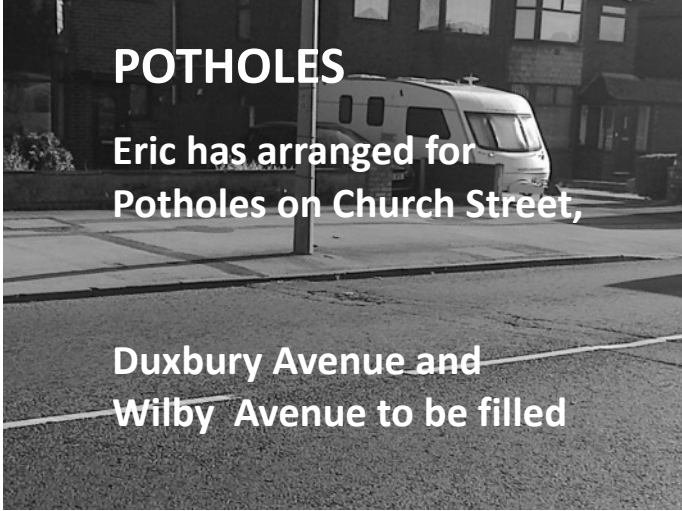
## NO THROUGH ROAD SIGN
